and in having distinctly finer and more delicate strie, which are also a little shallower; the puncta in the strie are similarly obscure, but the punctuation of the interspaces more profuse and more delicate. The length of the fragment is $1\cdot 8^{\rm mm}$, and the breadth, $1\cdot 3^{\rm mm}$; the real length of the elytron may have been nearly $4^{\rm min}$.
