Note.—That the above rates being for a fingle letter, it is to be observed, that a double letter must pay double the sum mentioned in this table; a treble letter, three times the sum, and an ounce weight, four times the sum, and so in proportion, accounting every ounce weight equal to four single setters.

The post sets off regularly, every Saturday at 4 o'clock in the afternoon, with the mails for all parts of the Country, from Halifax to Canada.—Letters to go in those mails must be put into the post office by 3 o'clock.

For the INFORMATION of TRAVELLERS between WINDSOR and PARRSBOROUGH, &c.

THE Parriborough packet, fails regularly between Windfor and Parriborough twice in every week, and occasionally three times to but is always at Windfor every Tuesday in the summer season (wind and weather permitting) so as to fail from thence for Parriborough, the first high water that happens at, or after, twelve o'clock on that day.—The passage money for each person is five shillings: And the freight for horses and neat cattle, is seven shillings and six pence per head—The vessel is forty two tons burthen, and hath good accomodations for passengers: And likewise for taking over horses, neat cattle and sheep, &c.
