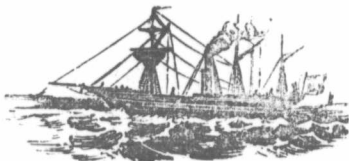

Passengers wishing to take train to Portland, can do so by the Morning and Noon Trains of Boston & Maine and Eastern Railroads from Boston, connecting with the Steamers at Portland at 6 00 p. m.

RETURNING.—A Steamer will leave St. John at 8.00 a. m., and Eastport at 1.00 p. m., for Portland and Boston on the same days as from Boston to Portland until July 1st; then every Sunday, Monday, Wednesday and Friday until further notice.

Usual running time between St. John and Eastport 4 to 4½ hours; Eastport and Portland, 15 to 17 hours; Portland to Boston, 8 to 9 hours.

CONNECTIONS.—At Portland with Portland and Ogdensburg Railroad to White Mountains and Lake Champlain; Portland and Worcester Line for Rochester, Worcester and Intermediate Stations; Grand Trunk Railway to the Mountains and all parts of Canada and the West. Boston and Maine and Eastern Railroads to Boston, and at Boston with Steamers and Railroads to all parts of the United States.
