ful, for the feveral Grand Juries in each County in this Province, at that Aff.zes and at the General Seffions of the Peace to make prefentment is they thick fit; and for the Judges and Julices to Confirm the fame, for the Raifing any Sum not exceeding Ten Pounds per Annum, to be paid to the Treasures of each County for his Services in that station, and also that it shall and may lawfull, for faid Grand Juries to prefent three or more good and sufficient Freeholders for every Township in faid County; to be Affeffors for faid Township, who are to be approved of by the Court, and are to be Sworn by the faid Court, or before any one of his Majefty's Juffices of the Peace, to the due and faithful Execution of the Office to which they are appointed, and that without Favour or Affection, Hatred or Malice, to the best of their Skill and Knowledge, and in cate any Perlon, who may be appointed as Afleffor as aforefaid, and thall Refute to accept the faid Office, another Perfon shall immedia ately be appointed in his stead by the Court, or by any two of his Majefty's Juffices of the Peace, and the Perion to Refuting thall Forfeit the Suntof Forty Shillings, to be Recover'd by Bill Plaint or Information in any of his Majesty's Courts of Record, or before any two of his Majesty's Juffices, and be paid to the Treasurer of the County, for the Use of the. County, wherein such Assessor was appointed.

And be it also further enasted, That the Judges of Affize or Judices in General Selfions for Each County, thall agree and determine each Respective Towns Proportion of the Sum so presented and Confirmed by the Court, and the Sum so proportion'd, thall be affeffed on the Inhabitants in Each Township, in the Justest and most Equal manner they can device, and the fame shall be levied by the Constables of the faid Townships Respectively, by Warrant under the hand and Seal of any two of his Majesty's Justices of the Reace for the faid County, and in Cafe of Result, by Distress and Sale of the Goods and Chattles of the Persons Resulting or Neglecting to pay the Sums Assessed on them as also chaid, with the Charge of such Distress and Sale, returning the Overplus if any; and in case any Person or Persons shall think themselves aggriev'd by such Adefinent or Levying thereof, they that be at Liberty to to appeal to the next General Selfions held for the County who are finally to determine the fame; and the Money when so Levied,
