Notice is hereby given that the Newfoundland Board of Trade acting in conjunction with the Minister of Shipping has covered by a policy of insurance all general cargo carried on vessels owned by the Reid Newfoundland Company, or chartered by them as common carriers, at a rate of 1 per cent. to cover both marine and war risk, which holds good to 31st October, 1918.

Any person or firm desiring to avail of this protection must notify the Secretary of the Board of Trade on or before the 25th day of September, 1918, of their intention to participate in the scheme, and give a guarantee that they will pay their proportion of the premium due on all shipments up to the expiry of the policy.
