

No exception is to be taken on the score of membership or non-member-ship of mi'itary bandsmen in any un-ion or society and no discrimination shall be made in consequence of such membership or non-membership, but are not allowed to interfere with the performance of military duties or to prevent bandsmen when in the uniform of their corps taking part in public or private engagements with other members of militia in uniform, of any like union or society.
