Discussion of President Proposal Develops Hope that an Anglo-American Treaty will be Accomplished

LONDON PAPERS MUCH IN

President Inclined to that Anglo-American will have Good Influence on European Powers

LONDON, March 18.—The tone in the newspapers of the day for an Anglo-American treaty continues unabated. Sir Edward Grey's speech before the International League last night appeared to remove one of the chief objections to the proposal. The Conservative press, though it would involve a defensive alliance, strong hopes are expressed for the treaty will soon be signed. The Daily Telegraph declares that negotiations will proceed like those undertaken at Washington, and thinks Anglo-American treaty might be followed by a similar German settlement.

Not Like Peace

The idea of a treaty is supported by the strongest imper like the Outlook, and the Review, the latter displaying a strong anti-American bias.

Turkish Troops in Yemen Rout Rebellious Tribes Many of Latter Killed

FRANKFURT, Germany, March 17.—A despatch from Salonika, Frankfurter Zeitung says Young Turks central command received a despatch from the hostilities in Yemen that the troops are putting the Arab everywhere, and that the guns have caused great havoc among the tribesmen. The Arabs have lost 200 in two fights, while 40 of the troops were killed.

Australian Strike

MELBOURNE, March 17.—Government has decided to intervene in the miners' strike, and a conference has been arranged for Monday. Little result is, however, expected from the action of the law.
