MORRISON IS DEAD
The Shubert's Murderer Goes to
a Higher Court

RELEASING April 28.—Thomas Morrison,
who drowned three of his children last Wed-
nesday night, died at 7 1/2 this morning. He
was not conscious and had not spoken since
10 o'clock last night. He died without a
struggle.

A post mortem examination was held this
afternoon by Dr. Ross and Dr. Barr and was
held in the Town Hall tonight.

The inquest was conducted by Coroner Mor-
ton. Coroner Morton presided. Mr. MacMillan
of Ontario appearing for the crown, Mr.
Morrison, the wife's deceased, related
that Morrison fell from a buggy last Decem-
ber and was killed. Morrison was a well-
known and highly respected citizen. He
had recently been elected president of the
Ontario Automobile Association.

Sarah and Alexander, the surviving child-
ren, again recounted the details of the
tragedy already published and Robert Mor-
rison, the neighbor who was called in by the
house and the discovery of Morrison writing
in agony near the car.

before he died, related the details of the
tragedy and stated that Morrison was a well-
known and highly respected citizen. He
had recently been elected president of the
Ontario Automobile Association.
