

# MINUTES OF THE SYNOD OF THE PRESBYTERIAN SYNOD OF NEW BRUNSWICK.

*Held at St. John, June and July 1866.*

## FIRST SESSION.

*St. David's Church, June 27th, 1866, 7 1-2 P. M.*

Meeting.

At which place and time the Synod of the Presbyterian Church of New Brunswick, met according to adjournment, when the moderator, the Rev. Lewis Jack, having preached from Phil. 1 chap. 15 and 18 verses, synod was constituted. The Roll of Synod was then formed when the Rev. James Gray was nominated and unanimously appointed moderator. The newly elected moderator having shortly addressed the court, synod proceeded with its usual business.
