The bursting of water pipes by freezing forms the subject of a letter by John Tyndall in The Plumber and Gecorator, n the course of which he states that the air does not play a sensible part in the bursting of water pipes. In his early days he was accustomed to give expression to the apparent paradox that there is no such thing as real uniformity in nature. In regard to pipes considered "almost uniform," the slightest accident, says Tyndall, on the interior surface, a specy of dirt, for example, will start the crystallization at one point rather than at another. That example, will start the crystalization at one point rather than at another. That the freezing should occur with absolute uniformity throughout a water pipe he regards as physically impossible. Specs of dirt will cause some portions of a pipe to be filled by a solid plug, while other portions continue filled with water.
