

- (b) within 15 days of making the request, in the case of a request made by the disputing Party.

12. A disputing Party shall deliver to the Secretariat a copy of a request made under paragraph 6 within 15 days of receipt of the request.

13. The Secretariat shall maintain a public register of the documents referred to in paragraphs 10, 11 and 12.

Article G-28: Documents to, and Participation of, the Non-Disputing Party

1. The UNCITRAL Transparency Rules shall apply with respect to the participation of the non-disputing Party in arbitration proceedings under this Section except as modified by this Chapter.

2. The disputing Party shall deliver to the non-disputing Party a copy of the request for consultations and other documents submitted along with that request within 30 days of the date those documents have been delivered to the disputing Party. The non-disputing Party is entitled, upon its request and at its cost, to receive from the disputing Party a copy of the evidence that has been tendered to the Tribunal, copies of pleadings filed in the arbitration, and the written arguments of the disputing parties. The non-disputing Party receiving such information shall treat the information as if it were the disputing Party.

3. The non-disputing Party may make oral and written submissions to a Tribunal only on questions of interpretation of this Agreement and has the right to attend hearings held under this Section.

Article G-29: Transparency of Proceedings

1. The UNCITRAL Transparency Rules, including in regard to public hearings and the participation of third parties, as modified by this Chapter, shall apply in connection with proceedings under this Section.

2. A decision on arbitrator challenge, a request for consolidation, and an agreement to mediate made after the commencement of arbitral proceedings shall be included in the list of documents to be made available to the public under Article 3(1) of the UNCITRAL Transparency Rules.

3. Exhibits shall be included in the list of documents to be made available to the public under Article 3(2) of the UNCITRAL Transparency Rules.

4. Notwithstanding Article 2 of the UNCITRAL Transparency Rules, prior to the constitution of the Tribunal, the disputing Party shall make publicly available in a timely manner relevant documents pursuant to paragraph 2, subject to the redaction of confidential information. Such documentation may be made publicly available by communication to the repository referred to in paragraph 8 of this Article.
