8. The delegation shall be identified as "Canada" and shall parade behind the Maple Leaf. The flags of Quebec and New Brunswick shall follow immediately thereafter, on either side. The delegation shall march as a single group. Its components - Canada, Canada-Quebec and Canada-New-Brunswick - shall parade in that order, preceded by placards bearing the aforementioned identifying symbols.

- 9. The participants shall wear identical uniforms bearing the Maple Leaf; in addition, the Canada-Quebec and Canada-New-Brunswick components shall bear a distinctive crest on their uniforms.
- 10. When a victory is won by the Canadian delegation, the Canadian flag shall be raised and the Canadian national anthem played. In addition, when a victory is won by the Canada-Quebec or Canada-New Brunswick components, the flag of the component concerned shall be placed behind the winner's podium on a pole 3 metres tall.
- 11. On the financial level, and in accordance with the provisions established by the International Committee of the Francophone Games, each government shall pay the registration fees, fees proportional to the number of its participants, and transportation costs. Canada, Quebec and New Brunswick shall also contribute to the multilateral budget for the games, on the basis of the assessed contributions used by the Agency for Cultural and Technical Cooperation. Expenses for national or provincial incidentals relative to the selection and preparation shall be paid by the governments concerned.
- 12. A federal-provincial committee, consisting of representatives from the Department of External Affairs of Canada, the Department of International Affairs of Quebec and the Department of Intergovernmental Affairs of New Brunswick, shall be formed to coordinate areas of common concern to the three components of the Canadian delegation.

This committee shall be responsible for all the cooperative efforts required among the components, on a basis of consensus, prior to and during the Francophone Games, as statutorily practiced within the Francophone institutions. This committee shall appoint one or more sub-committees for the more technical aspects, in particular where sports and culture are concerned.
