

Wheat Board Act of 1935, proposed application of provisions of, to oats, barley, rye and flax produced in the Western Provinces:

Resolution,—Mr. Perley (Qu'Appelle), debate adjourned, 108. Withdrawn, 418.

Wheat Crop (1930) Equalization Payments Act:

1. Resolution,—To provide for the payment of certain sums of money to the Canadian Wheat Board for distribution to primary producers of wheat in the provinces of Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta who delivered wheat grown in 1930 to Canadian Co-operative Wheat Producers, Limited, through their respective pool organizations; for the payment by the Canadian Wheat Board to Canadian Co-operative Wheat Producers, Limited, of the net credit balance resulting from transactions by Canadian Co-operative Wheat Producers, Limited, in respect of coarse grains grown in the year 1930; and for the payment of the reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of the Act; House to go into Committee on, 173. Progress reported from Committee of the Whole, 188. Resolution adopted, 190. Bill No. 22 (Mr. Gardiner) An Act to provide for the payment of certain sums of money to primary producers of wheat with respect to wheat of the 1930 crop delivered to provincial pool organizations; 1st R., 190. 2nd R. moved; Debate adjourned, 198. Debate resumed and interrupted at 11 o'clock p.m., 201. 2nd R. agreed to, 205 (on division). Bill reported from Committee of the Whole, with amendments, 205. 3rd R. agreed to, 211-212 (on division). Passed by Senate with an amendment, 231. Senate amendment agreed to, 236. R.A., 240. 1 Edward VIII, Chapter 12.
