Accordingly, the said bill was read the third time and passed.

Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Agriculture, was again considered at the report stage.

Whereupon the House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Gleave, seconded by Mrs. MacInnis,—That Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, be amended by deleting the following words from subclause (1) of Clause 11 in lines 35 to 38 at page 10:

“or has, otherwise than by delivery to the Board, disposed of all or part of the grain in respect of which the advance was made.”

And the question being put on the said motion, it was negatived, on division.

Mr. Korchinski, seconded by Mr. Muir, moved,—That Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, be amended by adding in Clause 5 the words “the type of grain on which an advance was taken” after the word “grain” in line 31 at page 3.

Mr. Korchinski, seconded by Mr. Horner, moved,—That Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, be amended by deleting in Clause 5 the words “the making of the advance payment” in lines 5 and 6 at page 4 and substituting the following words therefor “the final delivery of grain on which collection was made in repayment of an advance”.

Mr. Korchinski, seconded by Mr. Horner, moved,—That Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, be amended by adding in Clause 5 the words “except where such discharge is by delivery of grain where a deduction is made which is greater than the rate of advance” after the word “payment” in line 15 at page 4.

Mr. Korchinski, seconded by Mr. Horner, moved,—That Bill C-239, An Act to amend the Prairie Grain Advance Payments Act, be amended by deleting in Clause 6 the words “the making of the advance payment” in lines 8 and 9 at page 5 and substituting the following words therefor “the final delivery of grain on which a deduction was made for an advance”.

And debate arising thereon;

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed Bill C-241, An Act to amend the Prime Minister's Residence Act, without any amendment.
