## NOTICES OF MOTIONS.

For Friday, March 11th, 1870.

1870.  
9th March.—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will be pleased to cause to be laid before this House a copy of the minute of Council, dated 9th April, 1869, sanctioning a re-survey of the line of Intercolonial Railway, between *Bathurst* and the European and North American Railway: a copy of the Memorial laid before the Commissioners at *Saint John*, and referred to in the Report of March 3rd, 1869; returns of the surveys of the two lines from the *Miramichi* River, to the European and North American Railway, giving the following information respecting each; the dates at which each survey commenced and terminated; the names of all persons employed in each month, with the rates of wages, and the number of days for which each man was paid monthly; copies of all accounts of money paid for food and other necessaries; for transplanting men and materials, and for all other expenses connected with the surveys; with the names of persons authorised to purchase or contract for the same; and of those to whom payments were made; also copies of all reports or documents submitted to the Chief Engineer, when called on to report on the comparative merits of the two lines; and a copy of his report.
