Resolution passed at the General Meeting of The Royal Society, May 21st. 1920.

RESOLVED THAT :-

In the opinion of your committee on science and scientific conditions in Canada productive research in our universities and the training of research men are of the very first order of importance for the development of the country.

We therefore recommend that :-

- (a) The appointment of heads of scientific departments in our universities should be made primarily on the ground of research qualifications.
- (b) That those members of the teaching staff who are qualified to do research work should be encouraged to follow their inclination and adequate aids thereto should be furnished whether in the form of additional keep or added equipment and supplies.
