

(5) Christian and social service workers in every city should make up and advertise a list of inspected and *safe and comfortable boarding houses* for girls and women wage-earners. This is vital.

(6) Though it may be difficult and delicate and often unpleasant work it is becoming absolutely essential that *the young* of both sexes be *instructed in the purpose and problems and perils of sex*, including information as to the awful penalty nature imposes, in the form of social diseases, such as syphilis and gonorrhœa, well designated the Black Plague, upon those who violate her laws of sex, and not only upon the guilty, but upon the innocent and pure with whom these guilty afterwards wed.

(7) To give any sort of general effect to the above suggestions, *organization is essential*. What is everybody's business is nobody's business and will not be done.

In every centre therefore there should be a Moral and Social Reform Council, and in connection therewith a Social Purity Vigilance Committee, constitutions for both of which will be supplied by the publishers of this pamphlet.
