FERTILIZERS AS SOLD

DEAR SIR,—I have the honour to present you the results of analysis of 88 samples of Fertilizers, purchased in the open market during the months of April, May and June of this year.

This procedure is in accordance with the terms of Section 5 of the Fertilizers Act, which requires not only that manufacturers, importers or vendors shall furnish standard samples of the brands which they propose to place on the market, but that such action shall not limit the right of the inspector to procure samples for analysis in accordance with the subsequent provisions of the Act.

The samples now reported may be classified as follows:—
