" the Petition of the House of Representatives of " Massachuset's Bay, containing divers Charges " against Sir Francis Bernard, your Majesty's "Governor of that Province; and also a Petition " of the faid Sir Francis Bernard, praying, That " an early day might be appointed, to examine the " feveral articles of complaint exhibited against " him; and likewise a Petition of Dennis De Berdt, " Agent for the House of Representatives of the " faid Province, praying, That due time and op-" portunity might be allowed to make good the " allegations contained in the complaint against "Governor Bernard:—The Lords of the Commit-" tee, in obedience to your Majesty's said order of " reference, did, on the 21st of December, take " the faid feveral Petitions into confideration; and it appearing, by the aforementioned Petition of. 46 Sir Francis Bernard, that, a few days before " he embarked for England, he obtained a copy of "the charges alledged against him, and was prea pared to make his answer thereto; their Lordthips thought proper to appoint Saturday the 27th of January to hear the same: but your " Majesty Laving been pleased, by another order " of Council of the 19th of January, to refer unto " this Committee a further Petition of the faid " Dennis De Berdt, praying, That the trial of the " complaints against Governor Bernard might be deferred fome months, in order that due time 66 may
