by two circumstances: 1. Its size; and 2. The large quantity of matter in its pages applicable only to Methodism in the United States. With a view of adapting it to general circulation in Canada, this abridgment has been made. Everything essential to the line of argument and illustration has been retained; but enough has been omitted to bring the volume into moderate compass, and to place it, as regards cost, within the reach of all.
