Duane, John Alsop, \* John Jay, Simon Boerum, William Floyd, \* Henry Wisner, \* Philip Schuyler, \* George Clinton, Lewis Morris, \* Francis Lewis, and \* Robert R. Livingston, jun. Esquires, were unanimously elected Delegates, to represent this Colony at such Congress, with full power to them or any five of them, to meet the Delegates from the other Colonies, and to concert and determine upon such measures as shall be judged most effectual for the preservation and re-establishment of American rights and privileges, and for the restoration of harmony between Great-Britain and the Colonies.
