REPORT OF DEPUTATION TO WAIT ON SIR CHARLES TUPPER.

To the Warden and Councillors for the County of Welland.

We, the undersigned Members of the County Council, being a deputation appointed by resolution of your Honorable Council to wait on Sir Charles Tupper, Minister of Railways and Canals, who visited the Town of Welland yesterday, beg to report that your deputation met that Honorable Gentleman at the Welland Railway Station, and Mr. Lee, Chairman of Marsh Lands Committee, addressed the Honorable Commissioner on the importance and necessity of the Government causing the Culverts under the Feeder of the Welland Canal, being enlarged, and the back ditches being deepened and enlarged on either side of the Feeder, in order to afford a better outlet for the
