**UNIQUE WAR AT DENVER.**

Department stores want newspapers to cut prices for advertising and they refuse. Denver, Col., Jan. 13.—An extraordinary contest has started in this city with the daily papers on one side and 14 of the largest dry goods and clothing department stores on the other. No advertisements of any kind of these firms appear in yesterday's papers, and formal notice has been given that none will appear until the papers accede to the demands of the merchants. Last week the business managers of the dailies were informed that the department store combination had arbitrarily decided to reduce advertising rates to not more than 20 per cent. The firms declined to enter into the discussion of the justice of their demand, simply stating that they had given their ultimatum. They control about 50 per cent. of the city advertising, and believed the papers must submit to their dictation, notwithstanding the fact that Denver is larger than in any other city of the same size in the country. The newspapers replied that concession to the department stores would not be possible for business reasons, but would destroy the independence of the press. A resolution by the Trades Assembly calling on the City Council to impose a heavy license on department stores, and warning all members of the labor union to boycott them. The smaller merchants are taking advantage of the opportunity to increase their advertising, and are exceedingly glad of the chance to cut into the business of their larger rivals.
