Professor Surface says that the young orchard should be cultivated with but not with grain or grass crops. Corn, potatoes, beans or other vegetables, well cultivated, are ideal for a young orchard. But the farmer must in some cases deprive himself of any return from the land for a year or two in order to insure the best growth and quickest returns from his trees.

A gentleman living near Shelby, Michigan, picked his sweet cherries in the California cherry box, having every cherry carefully and shipped them across the lake to Milwaukee, and received for his trouble in handling his cherries right \$7 per box, or over \$2000 net per acre.

In Bulletin 95 of the Ohio Experiment Station, Prof. H. A. Gossard, gives the data of the results of perfect spraying on a twelve acre orchard of apples on the farm of John A. Bunker of Fremont, Sandusky County. The orchard contained one hundred and fifty barrels of fruit was gathered from the entire orchard which sold for \$4000.

One of the most useful methods employed for protecting trees from rabbits is to use a thin veneer wood wrapper, which is bent about the tree trunk and fastened with wire. This can be kept on through the winter months. The paper is sometimes successfully employed on fruit trees for keeping out rabbits, but it has proven injurious to trees, and for that reason one should use caution in applying it.

The tendency to establish grades and brands of fruits, seems to be taking hold of the minds of fruit growers now and more. These efforts are made to make the most of the product, and this can be done most effectively by putting out a product that can be traced to the packer and is put out under a brand that has someone or some association back of it from whom the buyer has redress in case the goods are not as represented.

Enos Remmer's young orchard in Pickering, from nine to fifteen years old will return this season 700 barrels of choice Baldwin and Spies. The government has purchased two carloads from him. The returns will likely be a big profit for the young man's crop. He sprays often and well.

For spraying rose bushes, arsenite of lead is far more beneficial than is kail green. The latter arsenite kills in holes in the leaves, where the five grains of free arsenic fall, whereas it is almost impossible to apply the lead strong enough to cause leaf injury.

Apples buried in pits are always improved in flavor and crispness if the work is well done. The fruit should first be well lined with clean straw, upon which the fruit should be carefully placed. This means not dumping in, but handling the fruit with care. The house is in the open air, and the better the quality the better results. As stated above, the work is much improved by such storage, but its keeping qualities will be greatly lessened when again exposed to the air.
