The PRESIDENT (Mr. James McDougall) having taken the chair, instructed the Secretary (Mr. G. DURNFORD) to read the notice convening the meeting.

It was moved by Mr. R. White, seconded by Mr. Macrae, Q.C., "That the minutes of the last annual meeting having been printed and distributed, be taken as read and confirmed." Carried.

The Secretary then read the following report, which was accompanied by the usual statements:—

TO THE PROPRIETORS OF THE MOUNT ROYAL CEMETERY CO. :-

The Trustees beg to submit their Annual Report and Statement for the year 1885.

The following is a summary of the improvements done in the Cemetery during the past year, as reported by the Superintendent:—

Gravelling the main approach to the Cemetery, and putting the road in good order. A gang of six men have been working all this season on the rock excavation, and building the large culvert. Your Trustees are happy to say that this long and expensive work is now completed to the end of the rock work. There is still about 300 yards of the main culvert to be built between the end of the rock work and the Park Bridge. The earth taken from this part of the avenue can be used for filling lots where required.
