Since last Annual Report the strength of the Congregation has been increased by the addition of several families, and the Session have welcomed to Church fellowship 36 new members, of these 17 were admitted on profession of faith, and 19 were received by certificate from other congregations. During the same time 24 were removed from the Communion Roll-8 by certificate, 7 by death, and 9 by action of the Session. The present membership numbers 581, being a net increase of 12 members in the past year. The names of the members are given in the closing pages of the Church Report. In looking over the list, the older members of the Congregation will miss the names of persons who had for many years hitherto appeared on the Roll, some of whom have been removed by certificate to join congregations nearer to their places of residence in the city, or with those in other parts of the Dominion, where they may still enjoy the fellowship of the Church, and, if so disposed, engage in its work. Others, having finished their earthly course, have been called away to the higher fellowship of the Church above. The Session would now extend to the bereaved relatives their sincere sympathy and prayerful solicitude for their spiritual comfort and consolation.
