year; and no person who shall not on or before that day have paid their subscription for the year commencing and computed from the first Tuesday in June previous, shall be considered a Member of the Corporation, or be entitled to vote at any General Meeting thereof.

XIII. An Endowment Fund of this Society shall be established, and subscribers thereto of fifty pounds in one sum, or donation of land equivalent to that amount, shall be entitled to nominate one orphan to the charity, who shall be immediately admitted if duly qualified according to the Rules and Regulations. And the said donor, on the death, apprenticeship or removal of the said orphan, may nominate another in place thereof, so that such donor shall always be entitled to have one orphan in the house during the donor's lifetime.

XIV. That the sanction of the Members of the Sale or Mort-Corporation, or a majority of them present at a General Meeting convened for the purpose, shall be necessary to the validity of any Sale or Mortgage of the Lands, Tenements or Hereditaments of the Corporation, or of any part them.
