Sir,-

I beg to draw your attention to memorandum from Mr Pedley Dy. Sup't Gen'l to the Hon. Mr. Oliver dated 25th April, 1907 (Our Number 16421) and to a memorandum from the Chief Clerk Mr. N. O. Cote addressed to Mr. J. W. Greenway Commissioner of Dominion Lands dated 6th May following, relating to the tract of land in which it is proposed to select a new reserve for the Thunderchild Band.

The said tract of land consists of Tps. 52, 53 and 54, Ranges 19, 20 and 21 as shown on the map herewith enclosed. Mr. Cote has explained in his said memorandum the extent to which the said Townships are available for the purposes of an Indian Reserve, I shall be obliged, if the same has not already beandone, if you will be good enough to reserve all the lands still available in the said tract from sale or settlement or other action until we have been able to have the new reserve selected.
