While I was running a bolt cutter at the Rock Island shop in Chicago, writes a contributor to Railway and Locomotive Engineering, I boarded at a house much frequented by locomotive engineers and firemen. These men talked a great deal about their tremendous feats in getting over certain hills without the help of a second locomotive.

My opposite neighbor at a table, a young fellow who ran a lathe in the shop, grew tired of this monotonous bragging; he thought he was entitled to do a little talking himself. One evening he called out to me:

"Well, I went over and saw the new machine today, and it's astonishing the fine work it does."

"How does it work?" I inquired.

"Well," said James, "by means of a pedal attachment, a fulcrum lever converts a vertical reciprocating motion into a circular movement.
