NOTICE TO SPORTSMEN
The New Brunswick Game Act was amended during the last session of the Legislature in the following respects:

LICENSE FEES
The fee for license to hunt and kill one bull moose, and one bull caribou and two deer will be to a non-resident of the Province, \$50.

TRAPPING OF GAME
It is unlawful to trap any game except such fur-bearing animals as are exempt by the Game Act.

BIRD LICENSES
A \$50 non-resident hunter's license carries with it the right to shoot game birds.

WILD GOOSE AND BRANT TAKEN BY RESIDENTS OF THE PROVINCE FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES
The section relating to the taking of goose and brant, as above described, has been repealed.
