easily explained. 4. The claimants have been paid in full, and the debt with which we commenced the year, has been reduced \$1,667.25, leaving only a balance of \$1,044.95.

5. On the whole, the working of the new law has been an encouraging success during this, the first year of its existence, and augurs well for the future. I do not claim for it absolute perfection, but it cannot be changed till the next General Conference. As we cannot "mend" it till then, let us, as ministers and laymen, "keep it," and with the improvements that may be made at the next General Conference, it will be a lasting blessing to the Church in all time to come.
