FEARFUL PLIGHT OF THE POLES

Fourteen in Cellar Living On Frozen Turnips. SCRAPE DISCARDED TINS. Edouard de Reske, Famous Singer, Shares Cold Shelter With Destitute Prince and Princess.

New York, April 27.—The American Polish Relief Society has received a report from a representative in Poland whose headquarters are at Lycz, dealing with conditions among Polish non-combatants. One part of that report which indicates the terrible conditions reads: "In the farming district of Starles, our motor, laden with food and warm clothing, found fourteen people in the cellar of a half-demolished barn. They were subsisting on frozen turnips, which they managed to dig from the ground with iron bars. Five of their number had died, and one woman had given birth to a baby on the day previous. We helped them to build a better shelter and left them sufficient warm clothing and a month's supply of food. Women were eagerly gathering the now living in a cellar with scanty cover-
