TOO MANY FAT POLICEMEN.

Rev. Joseph Chasey Says "Lean Lankies" Catch the Crooks.

The New York police department has too many fat men, said the Rev. Joseph W. Chasey, pastor of the Metropolitan Temple, Seventh avenue and Fourteenth street, in his evening sermon on the crime wave.

"They may be all right for traffic
