

JOHN IRVIN AT THE **EVERY DAY CLUB** 

Takes Strong Plea for Children's Aid Society - Comparison of

In an admiratre address at the Every Day Club last evening John Irvin, K. C., of Briggetown, paid a very high tribute to the citizens of St. John for what had been accomplished in past years and made a very strong plea for the addition of a caldren's Aid Society with the law behind it, as a necessary addition to the splendid nstitutions related to the humanities which are already in existence.
