DEFICIT OF GOVERNMENT ENORMOUS

Figures Show it is Nearer \$300,000 Than Amount Admitted

A closer examination of the report reveals the fact that the actual deficit is in the vicinity of \$300,000 and, in addition to this, there is an increase in the bonded indebtedness of the province of \$315,000.
