- Q.123. Well what did you do?
- A.123. I went in and got the envelope and Morris and myself opened it up and counted the money.
- Q.124. And what was the contents?
- A.124. Four ten dollar bills.
- 2.125. What then took place?
- A.125. I handed it over to Lieut. Morris and he gave me a receipt.
- Q.126. And the person who gave you this money to hold, is he present in Court?
- A.126. That man there -- Lilley. (Pointing to the accused).

QUESTIONED BY THE COURT

- Q.127. Is it customary for you to act as sefe-keeper?
- A.127. This was the first time I ever did it. I just thought that I would do it -- I was an old soldier mysolf in the last war.
