In presenting the statistics the Clerk has to announce an error in last years Minutes. The number of members reported in the Minutes was 257 deficit the true number. The Total should have been 2319. To this we have to add the River John and Upper Londonderry 41 being 56 which increases that number to 2375. Some irregularities are found in the statistics of the letters of some 15 leaving us only 10 members clear increase.
