### "Your Teeth"

The First Molars

You cannot build a house upon the sand unless the sand is thoroughly mixed with cement and water and shaped into a firm foundation that extends well down into the earth.

The first or as they are frequently called, sixth-year-molars are the foundations of the dental arch in the mouth. These teeth are the largest and strongest of the permanent set. There are four of one on each side below.

When the first molars come they cause an immense amount of pressure. From the pain and reflex irritation of the nerves, children often exhibit serious symptoms such as violently inflamed mouth and throat, spasms of an epileptic type, dizziness, vomiting, head-

These wide reflexes are not surteeth and mouth, gives sensory cranial nerves. This means that an irritation in or about the mouth can affect the nerve supply of a large part of the body.

When these big molars finally get into place, the child's face is larger and the first definite step from infancy to youth has been taken. These are by far the most important teeth in the mouth. They govern the posi-tions of all of the other teeth of the permanent set. Irregular teeth, weak jaws, inexpressive apparatus are a few of the penalties that follow the loss of the first molars in childhood.

Unfortunately these teeth are found-decayed more frequently than are any other teeth in the mouth. From the sixth to the welfth year children should be xamined frequently by the family

### Wood Protection

The effect of the lumber scarcity, and its antecedent, the depletion of the forest, is being felt by the ambitious householder who undertakes to make his own epairs or improvements. Costs of materal are rapidly mounting, and the expens ntailed causes a delay in making repairs.

In many cases, however, the necessity for repairs is due to delay in protecting woodworks. By the use of paint, much of the labour and expense of renewal would be obviated. It is remarkable how little thought is given to the protection of wood where it is exposed to the weather. he alternate absorption and drying out of moisture are conducive to decay. By painting the woodwork, moisture is ex cluded and the life of the woo d will be greatly lengthened.
