## REGULATIONS

Of the Female Compassionate Society, established for the relief of poor married women in their confinement:

I. The Society shall consist of a Patroness, a Lady President, and twelve Directresses, a Secretary, Treasurer and Storekeepers—Six of the Directresses shall be Canadian and six English Ladies; one of each shall take the office of Acting Directress on the first Tuesday in every second month—A general meeting of the Directresses shall be held quarterly, and a Committee consisting of five, (of whom the Lady President shall be one) shall meet the first Tuesday in every month.

11. No person shall be admitted to the benefit of the charity without a recommendation to the Acting Directress, signed by two Subscribers, or a Certificate from a resident

Clergyman of the Protestant or Catholic Church.

III. The articles of clothing and nourishment shall be issued by the Storekeeper, on a Ticket from the Acting Directress, and the cloathing shall be returned to them within thirty days. On the Storekeeper's Certificate of their being complete and properly washed, a gratuity of
