CAMERON, WILLIAM (Pictou).

CHISHOLM, CHRISTOPHER, P. (Antigonish).

Of Highland Scotch descent. B. at Clydesdale, Antigonish, N.S., April, 1854. Ed. at St. Francis Xavier Coll. M., 26 June, 1890, Sarah, dau. of Arch. Campbell, Esq. Is a Barrister. First returned to Ho. of Assembly at by-election held 7 April, 1891, and re-elected 1894. A Liberal.— Antigonish, N.S.

CHURCH, Hon. CHARLES EDWARD (Lunenburg).

Of English and German descent. Paternal ancestors came to Am. 1622, with the Pilgrim fathers. Great grandfather, Charles Church, a Loyalist, removed from U.S to N.S. during the Am. revolution; grandfather, Lot Church, represented Luvenburg in N.S. Assem. between 1820 and 1830. B. at Tancook Island, Luvenburg, N.S., 3 Jan., 1835. Ed. at Chester and Truro. M., 24 June, 1884, Miss Henrietta Pugeley of Halifax. Taught school for about 10 years, and subsequently became a merchant. Has held official positions of trust in the Grand Lodge British Templars, and in the Grand Division of the Sons of Temperance, N.S.
