

An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Montreal School of Medicine and Surgery.

WHEREAS in consideration of the great usefulness and high character of the Montreal School of Medicine and Surgery, it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Montreal School of Medicine and Surgery;" Be it enacted, &c., as follows:—

I. For and notwithstanding anything in the said Act, no member of the Corporation by the said Act established, shall be considered as having ceased to be a member thereof by reason of his having become a permanent resident out of the City of Montreal, nor shall it be necessary to appoint another person in the stead of such member; and the said Corporation may appoint so many Professors for instruction in the different branches of Medical Science in the said School, not being at any time less than eight in number, as they shall deem expedient.

II. The sixth Section of the said Act shall be repealed; and any Student in Medicine who shall have attended courses of lectures in the said School of Medicine and Surgery, on the various branches of Medical Science mentioned in the twelfth Section of the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and Surgery therein," shall, after an examination, which shall be public before the Professors of the said School of Medicine and Surgery (five of whom shall form a quorum for holding the said examination) receive, if he be deemed duly qualified, a Diploma from the said School of Medicine and Surgery, and thereupon be entitled to receive a license from the Provincial Medical Board without being required to undergo any examination before the said Board; anything in the Act last above mentioned or in any other Act or Law to the contrary notwithstanding.
