And it is hereby enacted by the authority of ThesaidAct of the same, That the said Act of the Legis-L.C. 9 G 4 lature of Lower Canada, passed in the ninth to have been in year of the Reign of His late Majesty, King Sept. 1831 5 George the Fourth, and intituled, An Act

for rendering valid conveyances of Lands and other immovable properly held in free and common soccage within the Province of Lower Canada, and for other purposes therein men-10 tioned, shall be and is hereby confirmed and declared to be in force within that part of this Province which formerly constituted the said Province of Lower Canada, thereinafter called Lower Canada,) and shall be deemed to 15 have been in force therein as law, since the first day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirtyone, being the day on which the Royal Assent to the said Provincial Act was so signi-20 fied by proclamation as aforesaid, and which shall be held to be the day of the passing thereof.

II. And be it enacted, That when any How free and proprietor of land or immovable properly cane lands of 25 granted or held in free and common soccage persons dying in Lower Canada, shall have died since the intestate after passing of the Provincial Act hereinbefore shall be parcited and confirmed, and either before or the heirs after the passing of this Act, without having 30 partitioned the same, either by last will or testament or otherwise, the heirs of such proprietor shall be held to partition such land or immovable property according to the old Laws of Lower Canada, unless the 35 said heirs should or shall have agreed among themselves on a different partition: Provided always, that nothing in this sec-Proviso tion shall be construed to invalidate any rights of third right acquired by prescription, or acquired saved 40 before the passing of this Act by any heir or other party, under the judgment of any competent Court, or acquired bond fide, for a valuable consideration, and before the passing of this Act, by any third party, from
