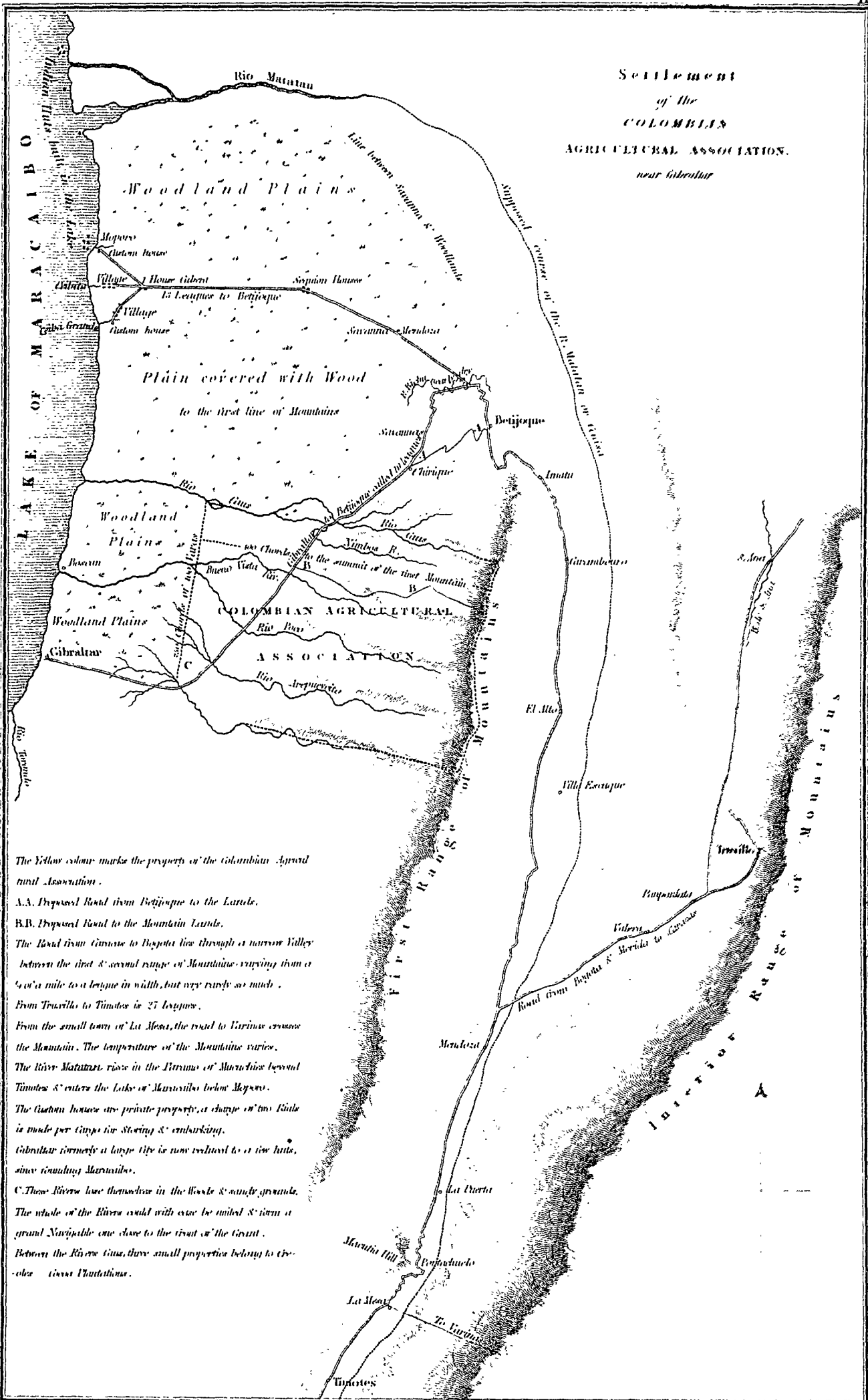


Settlement

A.A. Proposed Road from Betijoque to the Lariete.

B.B. Proposed Road to the Mountain Lands.

The Road from Gibraltar to Betijoque lies through a narrow Valley  
between the first & second range of Mountains varying from a  
1/2 of a mile to a league in width, but very rarely so much.

From Truarillo to Timotes is 27 leagues.

From the small town of La Mesa, the road to Timotes crosses  
the Mountain. The temperature of the Mountains varies.

The River Matatan rises in the Sierra of Maracibo beyond  
Timotes & enters the Lake of Maracibo below Mojoso.

The Custom houses are private property, a charge of two Reals  
is made per Carga for storing & embarking.

Gibraltar formerly a large City is now reduced to a few huts,  
since founding Maracibo.

C. These Rivers have themselves in the Woods & sandy grounds.

The whole of the River could with ease be united & form a  
grand Navigable one close to the rivet of the Great.

Between the Rivers Guine, there small properties belong to the  
other Great Plantations.
