be, shall take and prescribe the oath of allegiance and also Forms of such the oath contained in Schedule A of this Act, or such other oaths. oath as may, by some other Act, be in that behalf provided.

2. In the case of the Clerk of the Privy Council, and all Before whom officers under him, and in the case of any officer of whom to be taken. the Governor in Council shall require the same, there shall be added to the oath at the asterisks the words contained in Schedule B to this Act.

- 3. The Clerk of the Queen's Privy Council for Canada By Clerk shall take and subscribe the oaths before the Governor Council. General or some one appointed by him to take the same.
- 4. In case of persons residing or coming to reside at At Ottawa-Ottawa, the oaths shall be taken and subscribed before the Clerk of the Queen's Privy Council.
- 5. In other cases the oaths may be taken and subscribed Elsewherebefore a Justice of the Peace or other proper authority, who shall forward the same to the Clerk of the Queen's Privy Council.
- 6. The Clerk of the Queen's Privy Council shall keep a Oaths to be Register of all such oaths.
