The proceeds for the Red and Black have always gone to the Senior Class for graduation expenses and receptions. Unless there is a rapid revival of interest, this means of support will be absent this year.

Come on, people. The Red and Black has been

the highlight of the fall term. If we pitch in and help, there will be a show this year. If we don't, the tradition of fifteen years . . . and a lot of fun . . . will go right out the window.

Director Wilson says that to produce the show, he has to have immediate volunteers for the following acts:

- Thirty Chorus Members—Ability to sing is a negligible factor, both men and women required.
- A Dozen Skits—Anyone who can clown around and amuse an audience, the more people in it the better. And almost any group of people can blow up an idea into a skit in a brainstorming session.
