belonging down with Right bates or whether to succeed
with y^e 3 wooden Canoes & two bates as it was first designed we

is coming down with the men w^t makes some alteration
about the matters in hand and are afraid matters will not
go so expeditious as we hoped & expected in respect of getting
up y^e stores & provisions our express met Cap^t Nicolls a
little on this side of y^e great carrying place we believe
it will take a long time before y^e men gett up with the
stores & provisions to Ossweego Cap^t Schuyler & his
brother Peter with Lourens believe will sett out this
day from Schenectady Cap^t Schuyler & Lourence go a horse
back to make all the hast they can to gett up to morrow
