Sir,-

Referring to my letter of the 2nd ult. informing you of your appointment as Indian Agent for the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinté, I beg now to say that the amount of security required from you is \$2,000.

The Department will accept either the sole bond of a guarantee company for that amount or the joint bond of yourself in \$2,000 and of two sureties in \$1,000 each.

Should you prefer to furnish the latter form of security, upon your advising the Department of the names in full of your proposed bondsmen, with their occupations and post office addresses, a form of bond will be sent you for execution.

Forms acceptable is inclosed herewith.
