Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo with which you forwarded an account rendered at \$150.10 from the Six Nations Hospital for the care and maintenance thereof of Mrs. Jackson and also of Louis King; and in reply I beg to say that the calculation of time in connection with the said account does not appear to be correct. Seemingly Mrs. Jackson was in the hospital 24 weeks not 22 while Louis King was in the said institution 10 weeks and 4 days not 7 weeks and 4 days. The account is returned herewith in order that it may be correctly rendered.
