I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th Instant, in regard to request of Mr. Edward Hodgins for a remission of Interest on the balance of Principal in arrear on the purchase of Lot 7, Con. 20, Keppel.

Some years ago the price of this Lot was reduced from \$1.50 per Acre, to \$1.00 per Acre, and the Interest on such reduction, remitted, which action was taken under authority of an Order in Council based on special Examiners' report.


