


Ottawa, 11th January, 1915.

I beg to say that the Department is in receipt of a letter from Mr. J. N. Michaud, of Bathurst, in regard to the case of an Indian McCormack who has fractured his leg and who is in need of relief. The Department approves of assistance to the value of \$2.00 a week being furnished this man and his family, until he is again able to work.

Mr. Michaud also states that Mrs. McCormack is ill and that she requires a "uterine support" which will cost about \$4.00. You should arrange for the necessary purchase in her case.
